Frequently Asked Questions

Q: What is the purpose of the *Welcome Weekend*?

A: To get to know your fellow parishioners. To read and reflect on scripture, to experience Mass and the sacraments of Reconciliation and Communion in a special setting.

Q: How long does the weekend last?

A: It starts at 7:30 am Saturday morning and ends Sunday afternoon around 3:00 pm.

Q: I have dietary restrictions. Can that be accommodated?

A: There will be an abundance of great food. If you have dietary restrictions, let us know so we can accommodate.

Q: Will my family be able to contact me?

A: You will receive a number that will give your family 24-hour access in case of emergency.

Q: I have medical issues. Should I bring medication?

A: Bring your medications. If you have any special needs, just let us know and we will make every effort to address any needs that you may have. Contact any team member and note any health needs on the registration form.

Q: How much will it cost?

A: Nothing, the costs are covered by Epiphany Parish.

Q: I'm not comfortable in large groups. Will I have to talk about my life to strangers?

A: You will hear personal witnesses from the *Welcome* team members. You will only be asked to introduce yourself and participate in group prayers and discussions.

Q: I don't have a Bible and have never really read much of the Bible. Is that a problem?

A: You will receive a New Testament to keep. Many participants have little or no familiarity with the Bible so we're all in the same boat.

Q: I can't stay cooped up in a room for 36 hours. Do we have any free time?

A: There are frequent breaks and opportunities to walk around the grounds of the church.

Q: I have a busy schedule. Do I have to make a long on-going commitment to *Welcome*?

A: There is no time commitment beyond the 36 hours of the weekend. If you feel the calling to help others enjoy a similar *Welcome Weekend*, you can join the team of a future retreat.

Q: Will it be any fun?

A: You are guaranteed to laugh and enjoy some great fun and meals with your fellow parishioners.
